Here teachers have provided their recommendations of supplies that they believe will best serve students from the first day throughout the school year. The following, **while not required**, represent examples of what is useful; no particular brand is required to be purchased. Families may work from this list, or they may find it convenient to purchase one <u>EduKit</u>, an assembly of supplies that also helps raise money for the school. **Please note** individual teachers may request additional supplies not listed here; if this is the case, you will receive notice from these teachers directly.

- (2) 3 ring binders 2" recommended (for handouts)
- (1) 3 ring binder 1" (Lit/Comp)
- (1) Package of 5 or 8 tab section dividers (for placing into 3 ring binders)
- (3) 2 pocket plastic folder with brads solid color black (Music) other solid colors (History, Art)
- (2) Spiral notebooks 3-hole, 1 subject, college ruled, perforated
- (1) Package of 200 sheets loose-leaf paper college ruled (for placing into binders)
- (200) Sheets or (2) Graph paper notebooks perforated edge, 1/2" with light lines (Math)
- (1) Pkg. lined 3 x 5 index cards (for use in many classes)
- (1) 8.5 x 11 Hardbound sketchbook No rings permitted (Art)
- (6) Mechanical pencils preferred (Math, Music)
- (6-12) #2 Dixon Ticonderoga or Forest Choice pencils yellow, sharpened (Art)
- (1) Personal pencil sharpener with shaving catcher (no sharpeners in the rooms)
- (1) Rectangular erasers pink pearl or white
- (1) Set of 24 colored pencils not erasable or twist-up (Art)
- (4) Black ball-point pens (all classes)
- (4) Red ball-point pens (Math for making corrections)
- (1) Highlighter pens package of 4 (Lit/Comp, History)
- (2) Elmer's Glue sticks (Art)
- (1) Zippered pencil case or box (to hold supplies)
- (1) 12" metric ruler firm, non-bendable (Math, Art, Lit/Comp)
- (1) Small stapler and staples
- (1) Pair of 6" scissors (Art)
- (1) Scientific Calculator TI-30X, TI-30XS/CALC 145
