Here teachers have provided their recommendations of supplies that they believe will best serve students from the first day throughout the school year. The following, **while not required**, represent examples of what is useful; no particular brand is required to be purchased. Families may work from this list, or they may find it convenient to purchase one <u>EduKit</u>, an assembly of supplies that also helps raise money for the school. **Please note** individual teachers may request additional supplies not listed here; if this is the case, you will receive notice from these teachers directly.

- (2) 3 ring binders 2" recommended (for handouts)
- (1) 3 ring binder 1.5" (Spanish/French)
- (1) 3 ring binder .5 inch, black, for drama scripts (11th/12th grade Drama)
- (2) Package of 5 or 8 tab section dividers for placing into 3 ring binders (one for Spanish/French)
- (1) 2 pocket plastic folder solid color (12th grade Art)
- (3) Spiral notebooks 3-hole, 1 subject, college ruled, perforated (all grades, but 9th grade Biology and 10th grade Chemistry each need one per semester)
- (3) Package of 200 sheets loose-leaf paper college ruled (for placing into binders)
- (2) Graph paper notebooks perforated edge, "" with light lines (9th to 12th grade Math)
- (1) Composition notebook 100 Sheets, college ruled (9th grade Poetry, 11th grade Drama)
- (3) Pkgs. lined 3 x 5 index cards (Science, Spanish)
- (1) 8.5 x 11 Hardbound sketchbook No rings permitted (11th/12th grade Art)
- (1) Box #2 pencils Mechanical pencils preferred (Math)
- (6-12) #2 Dixon Ticonderoga or Forest Choice pencils yellow, sharpened (11th/12th grade Art)
- (1) Personal pencil sharpener with shaving catcher (no sharpeners in the rooms)
- (1) Rectangular eraser pink pearl or white
- (1) Set of 24 colored pencils not erasable or twist-up (9th grade Biology, 10th grade Chemistry, 11th/12th grade Art)
- (1) Pkg. Black ball-point pens
- (1) Pkg. Red ball-point pens (Math, Science)
- (2) Highlighter pens package of 4, multicolor (Humane Letters, 9th grade Biology, 11th grade Drama)
- (1) Expo Dry Erase Marker fine tip, black (9th grade Biology, 10th grade Chemistry)
- (1) Sharpie Marker fine tip, black (9th grade Biology, 10th grade Chemistry)
- (2) Elmer's Glue sticks (11th/12th grade only)
- (1) Zippered pencil case (to hold supplies)
- (1) 12" metric ruler firm, non-bendable (9th to 12th grade Math, Art, Science)
- (1) Protractor (9th grade only)
- (1) Small stapler and staples
- (1) GRAPHING calculator (see note below for details)

<u>CALCULATOR NOTES:</u> All 9th through 12th grade students need a graphing calculator for math. It works best to buy any version of the TI-83 or TI-84. These models are key-for-key compatible; the main difference is a slightly faster processor and more memory in the TI-84. **DO NOT PURCHASE** a TI-89, TI-92, TI-Nspire CAS (non-CAS is OK), or anything with a QWERTY keypad. These calculators have functions that are prohibited during assessments. Students are free to buy another brand (e.g. Casio, Sharp, HP); however, teachers will be instructing based on the TI calculators and will likely be unable to provide support. **ANY OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE FORBIDDEN.**
