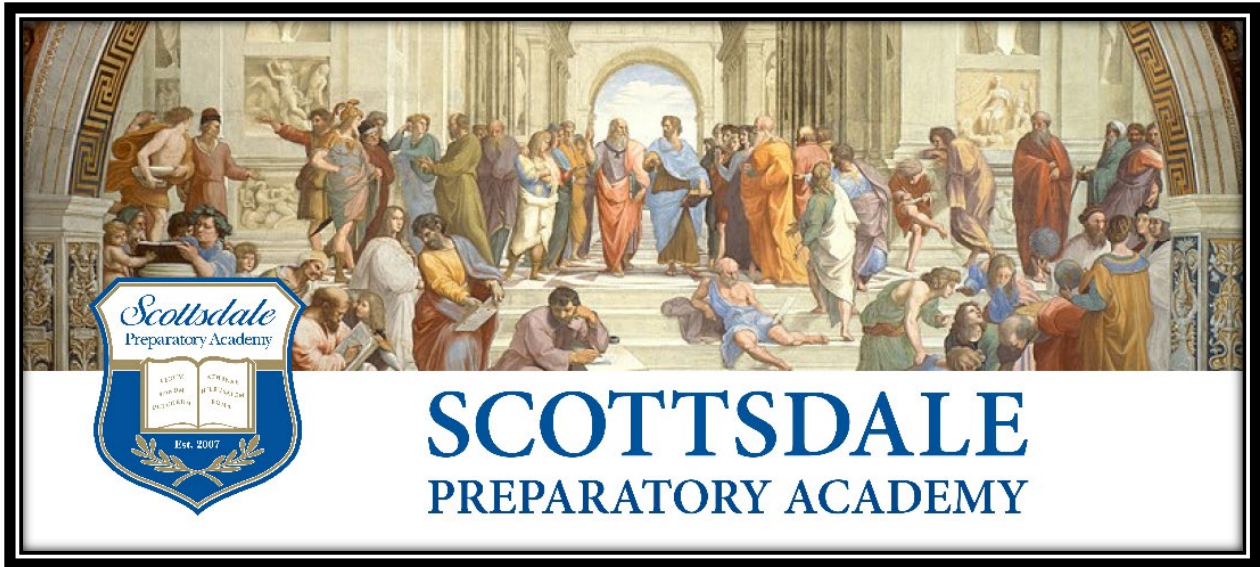


2024 SPA SUMMER ACADEMY COURSE CATALOG

PREPARATION COURSES

COURSE	DESCRIPTION
INTRODUCTION TO 6TH GRADE MATH	Basic skills to prepare for Pre-Algebra. This course is for students who are entering 6 th grade. Fee: \$350 Session 1: June 3-14 8:00 am – 12:00 pm
PREP for PREP for INCOMING 6TH-8TH Grades	This course is designed for incoming 6 th -8 th graders new to the academy to familiarize them with the school's culture and Socratic practices. It is a good opportunity to practice and form classroom habits and note-taking skills through short lessons, reading, and exercises. Fee: \$150 Session 1: June 10-14 1:00 pm – 3:00 pm

6th GRADE WRITING PREPARATION	<p>Grammar and Essay Writing. Preparation for incoming 6th grade students. Fee: \$150 Session 1: June 3-7 1:00 pm – 3:00 pm</p>
COMPOSITION CAMP for INCOMING 7th-8th GRADES	<p>Grammar and Essay Writing. This course is for new students transferring to SPA for 7th/8th grade. Fee: \$150 Session 1: June 3-7 1:00 pm – 3:00 pm</p>

REMEDICATION COURSES

The following classes are offered to 23/24 SPA students who have failed the course and therefore need remediation.

COURSE	DESCRIPTION
PRE- ALGEBRA	<p>This course is for 6th grade students from the 2023-2024 school year in need of remediation. Fee: \$350 Session 2: June 17-June 28 (No session on June 19th) 8:00 AM – 12:00 AM</p>
INTERMEDIATE ALGEBRA	<p>This course is for 7th grade students from the 2023-2024 school year in need of remediation. Fee: \$350 Session 2: June 17- June 28 (No session on June 19th) 8:00 AM – 12:00 AM</p>
LATIN I	<p>This course is for 6th grade students from the 2023-2024 school year in need of remediation. Fee: \$350 Session 1: June 3-14 8:00 am – 12:00 pm OR Session 2: June 17-June 28 (No session on June 19th) 8:00 am – 12:00 pm</p>
LATIN II	<p>This course is for 7th grade students from the 2023-2024 school year in need of remediation. Fee: \$350 Session 1: June 3-14 8:00 am – 12:00 pm</p>

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

The [Scottsdale Prep Family Handbook](#) is the governing policy document.

Course Guarantee: Scottsdale Prep reserves the right to cancel any course offering due to insufficient enrollment. All enrollees will be given at least one week's notice and refunded in full.

Payment and Refunds: Contact Mr. Gore with questions about payments. Payments must be made before the start of the first class. There will be no refunds issued after the first day of the session and any refund issued before the first day of the session will be charged a \$50 non-refundable deposit. Classes cannot be prorated due to absence.

Dress Code: Students must wear their school uniform to summer school. All other policies regarding personal appearance are governed by the SPA [Dress Code](#). Please click the link and review the policy. Exceptions are noted below:

NOTE: Students from other Great Hearts' academies (including those coming from Archway) are welcome to wear their current uniforms but will otherwise be held accountable to SPA dress code standards.

Students new to Great Hearts may order their uniforms in time for summer school or may wear other clothing that fits with the uniform code (a white or navy polo shirt with khaki shorts/pants, for example, without the school's crest would be appropriate for summer classes).

Shoes must be solid black or brown and closed toed. 6th grade students may wear solid white tennis shoes.

Pickup & Drop-Off: Students may be dropped off at school as early as 7:45 am and must be picked up no later than 15 minutes following the end of their registered course(s). Parents should drop off and pick up students at the front of SPA. Failure to pick-up your student on time may result in immediate withdrawal from summer classes without credit or refund. If a family needs their student to leave class early, a parent/guardian should email Mr. Gore at least 24 hours ahead of time. Students will not be released from class without parental notification.

Snacks are not provided by the school during summer school; please be sure to send snacks and a water bottle with your child if they need them during the day. For students that are taking morning and afternoon classes are highly recommended that they bring their lunch.

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Behavior: Students are expected to behave in a manner consistent with the behavioral expectations of Scottsdale Prep as outlined in the [SPA Family Handbook](#). Please click the link and review the policy. Students removed from a class or activity for disciplinary reasons will result in their withdrawal from the program and loss of course fee(s).
