- (1) 2 pocket plastic folder solid color (all courses for homework)
- (1) 2 pocket plastic folder with brads black (Music)
- (3) Spiral notebooks plastic cover 3-hole, 1 subject, college ruled, 8.5" x 11", 100 ct., perforated
- (2) Composition notebooks college ruled, 100 ct.
- (1) Hardbound sketchbook 5.5" x 8.5", 70 lb., No rings permitted (Art)
- (3) Packages of 100 sheets loose-leaf paper college ruled (for placing into class binders)
- (200) Sheets graph paper loose-leaf OR (2) Graph paper notebooks perforated edge, ¼" with light lines (Math)
- (1) Graph composition notebook, 4sq./in., 9.75" x 7.5", 100 ct., Black (no spiral binding)
- (1) Pack of index cards 3" x 5" ruled, 100 ct. (Math)
- (6) Mechanical pencils preferred (Math, Lit/Comp, History, Science, Latin, Music)
- (12) #2 Dixon Ticonderoga or Forest Choice pencils yellow, pre-sharpened (Art)
- (1) Set of 24 colored pencils **not** erasable or twist-up (Art, Science)
- (4) Black ball-point pens (all classes)
- (4) Red ball-point pens (Pre-Algebra, Science)
- (4) Blue ball-point pens (Math)
- (1) Pack of 5 Highlighter pens, 2 yellow (All Classes)
- (8) Expo Dry Erase Markers chisel tip, any color (Science, Latin)
- (1) Personal pencil sharpener with shaving catcher (no sharpeners in the rooms) (Math, Latin, Art)
- (1) Zippered pencil case or box (to hold supplies) 10"x 7.5" (Art)
- (1) 12" metric ruler firm, non-bendable (Pre-algebra, Art, Science)
- (1) Protractor Standard 6", Semicircular (angle measure) (Math)
- (1) Pair of 6" scissors (Art)
- (2) Glue Sticks (Art)
- (2) Rectangular erasers pink pearl or white (Math, Art)
- (1) Collapsible locker shelf for organizing binder/books inside locker (dimensions 36 ½" x 11 ¾") (recommended)
- (1) Zippered pencil case large (maximum 10" x 13") (to hold supplies) Option for students who prefer to carry **all** supplies in once case (including larger items e.g. Index cards, calculator, and planner (5.5" x 8.5"))
- (1) Scientific Calculator TI-30X, TI-30XS/CALC 145 (Pre-algebra, Physical Science) (required)
