



All-School Recommended Student Supply List 2024-2025

8th Grade

Here teachers have provided their recommendations of supplies that they believe will best serve students from the first day throughout the school year. The following, represent examples of what is useful; no particular brand is required to be purchased. Families may work from this list, or they may find it convenient to purchase one EduKit, an assembly of supplies that also helps raise money for the school. **Please note** individual teachers may request additional supplies not listed here; if this is the case, you will receive notice from these teachers directly.

- (6) 1 inch – 3 ring binders (for handouts) **OR** (2) 2-inch, 3-ring binders and (2) 1-inch, 3-ring binders
- (2) Packages of 5 or 8 tab section dividers (for placing into 3 ring binders) (Math, Lit/Comp)
- (2) 2 pocket plastic folders with brads – 1 black (Music), other solid color (Art)
- (1) Spiral notebook – Plastic cover, 3-hole, 1 subject, college ruled, 8.5" x 11", 100 ct. perforated
- (6) Composition notebooks – 100 Sheets, college ruled (2 History, 4 Science)
- (1) Hardbound sketchbook – 8.5" x 11", 70 lb., No rings permitted (Art)
- (200) Sheets loose-leaf paper – college ruled (for placing into binders)
- (250) Sheets graph paper loose-leaf **OR** (2) Graph paper notebooks – perforated edge, ¼" with light lines (Math)
- (1) Graph composition notebook, 4sq./in., 9.75" x 7.5", 100 ct., Black (no spiral binding)
- (1) Pack of Index cards – 3" x 5", ruled, 100 ct. (for use in many classes: Math, Latin)
- (6) Mechanical pencils preferred (Math, Science, Music, Latin, History)
- (6-12) #2 Dixon Ticonderoga or Forest Choice pencils – yellow, pre-sharpened (Art)
- (1) Set of 24 colored pencils – **not** erasable or twist-up (Art, Science)
- (4) Black ball-point pens (all classes)
- (4) Red ball-point pens (Math, Science, Latin)
- (4) Blue ball-point pens (Math)
- (1) Pack of 5 highlighter pens, 2 yellow – (Lit/Comp, History)
- (1) Personal pencil sharpener with shaving catcher (no sharpeners in the classrooms) (Art)
- (1) 12" metric ruler – firm, non-bendable (Math, Art, Science, optional Lit/Comp)
- (1) Pair of 6" scissors (Art)
- (2) Elmer's Glue sticks (Art)
- (1) Rectangular eraser – pink pearl or white (Math, Art)

- (1) Collapsible locker shelf for organizing binder/books inside locker (dimensions: 36 ½" x 11 ¾") (recommended)
- (1) Zippered pencil case or box medium 10" x 7.5" (to hold supplies) **OR** Zippered pencil case – large (to hold supplies) (maximum dimensions 10" x 13") – for students who prefer to carry **all** supplies in once case (including larger items e.g. Index cards, calculator, and planner (5.5" x 8.5"))

- (1) Scientific Calculator TI-30X, TI-30XS/CALC 145 (Math) (**required**)
