If that is the case, they will notify students directly.

Consumable Items/Kit:

- (2) 3 ring binders – 2” recommended (for handouts) (HL, Math, Chemistry, Music, Econ)
- (1) 3 ring binder – 1.5” (Mod. Lang. II (Spanish/French))
- (3) Packages of 5- section dividers (for placing into 3-ring binders)
- (4) 2 pocket plastic folders – solid color Black (Art) other solid colors (Spanish II (2), Chemistry)
- (2) Composition notebooks – 100 sheets, college ruled (Mod. Lang. II, Poetry)
- (2) Spiral notebooks – plastic cover, 3-hole, 1 subject, 8.5” x 11”, college ruled, perforated (HL, Chemistry)
- (1) Graph paper notebook - perforated edge, 8.5” x 11”, ¼” light lines. 70 ct. (Math)
- (1) Graph composition notebook, 4sq./in., 9.75” x 7.5”, 100 ct., Black (no spiral binding) (Chemistry)
- (2) Packs of loose-leaf paper, 150 ct. (300 sheets), college ruled (for placing into binders) (HL, Econ, Mod. Lang. II/Latin V)
- (3) Packs of graph paper loose-leaf - 80 ct. (240 sheets)- (Science (Chemistry))
- (2) Packs of index cards – 3 “x 5”, ruled, 100 ct. (Math, Chemistry, Mod. Lang. II)
- (1) Pack of mechanical pencils, 10 ct. (Math, Music, HL, Econ, Chemistry)
- (1) Pack of Black ball-point pens, 10 ct. (HL, Chemistry)
- (1) Pack of Red ball-point pens, 10 ct. (Math)
- (4) Highlighter pens, 2 yellow (HL, Mod. Lang. II, Econ, Chemistry)
- (1) Expo Dry Erase Marker – fine tip, black (Chemistry, Mod. Lang. II)
- (10) #2 Dixon Ticonderoga pencils- yellow, pre-sharpened. (HL)
- (1) Elmer’s Glue stick (Science)

Reusable Items/Kit:

- (1) Mini stapler and staples
- (1) 12” metric ruler – durable plastic, (Math)
- (1) Personal pencil sharpener with shaving catcher (no sharpeners in the rooms) (Math, HL)
- (1) Set of 24 colored pencils – **not** erasable or twist-up (Chemistry)
- (2) Rectangular erasers - pink pearl (Math) ((1) included in Full Kit)
- (1) Zippered pencil case, 9”x 10.5” (to hold supplies)

Add On Items:

- (1) Collapsible locker shelf for organizing binder/books inside locker, stackable (dimensions: 36 ½” x 11 ¾”) (**recommended**)
- (1) Zippered pencil case (to hold supplies) 9”x 10.5” (**Required** if you buy the Consumable Kit only **OR** families can opt-out if they have an item at home they want to use).
- (1) **Zippered pencil case**– large (9” x 12”) – (**Optional**) Carries **all** supplies in once case. (including larger items e.g. Index cards, calculator and planner) **Spartan** case available when you order your kit through First Day School Supplies.
- (1) GRAPHING calculator (Math) **Required**

CALCULATOR NOTES: It works best to buy any version of the TI-83 or TI-84. These models are key-for-key compatible; the main difference is a slightly faster processor and more memory in the TI-84. **DO NOT PURCHASE** a TI-89, TI-92, TI-Nspire CAS (non-CAS is OK), or anything with a QWERTY keypad. These calculators have functions that are prohibited during assessments. Students are free to buy another brand (e.g. Casio, Sharp, HP); however, teachers will be instructing based on the TI calculators and will likely be unable to provide support. **ANY OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE FORBIDDEN.**
