If that is the case, they will notify students directly.

#### Consumable Items/Kit:

- (2) 3 ring binders – 2” recommended (for handouts) (HL, Math, Biology, Music/Econ)
- (1) 3 ring binder – 1.5” (Mod. Lang. I (Spanish/French)
- (3) Packages of 5-tab section dividers (for placing into 3-ring binders) (Math, Biology, Mod. Lang. I)
- (3) 2 pocket plastic folders – solid color -1 black (Music), other solid colors Biology, Mod. Lang. I)
- (1) Composition notebook – 100 sheets, college ruled (Poetry)
- (2) Spiral notebooks – plastic cover, 3-hole, 1 subject, 8.5” x 11”, college ruled, perforated (HL, Biology)
- (1) Graph paper notebook - perforated edge, 8.5” x 11”, ¼” light lines. 70 ct. (Math)
- (1) Graph composition notebook, 4sq./in., 9.75” x 7.5”, 100 ct., Black (no spiral binding) (Science)
- (2) Packs of loose-leaf paper – 150 ct. (300 Sheets), college ruled (for placing into binders) (HL, Biology, Mod. Lang. I)/Latin IV)
- (3) Packs of graph paper loose-leaf - 80 ct. (240 Sheets) (Science)
- (2) Packs of index cards – 3 “x 5”, ruled, 100 ct. (Science, Mod. Lang. I)
- (1) Pack of mechanical pencils, 10ct. (Math, Music, HL, Biology)
- (1) Pack of Black ball-point pens, 10ct. (HL, Biology)
- (1) Pack of Red ball-point pens, 10ct. (HL, Math, Science)
- (4) Highlighter pens, 2 yellow (HL, Biology)
- (1) Expo Dry Erase Marker – fine tip, black (Biology, Mod. Lang. I)
- (1) Sharpie Marker – fine tip, black (Biology)
- (10) #2 Dixon Ticonderoga - yellow, pre-sharpened (HL)
- (1) Elmer’s Glue stick (Science)

**Reusable Items/Kit:** **NOTE for Protractor and Compass-** It’s recommended to buy the **Full Kit option** or families can opt-out if they have an item at home they prefer to use or buy separate)

- (1) Protractor – Standard 6” Semicircular, clear plastic (Math)
- (1) Metal 2-Piece Geometrical Compass (Math)
- (1) Set of 24 colored pencils – **not** erasable or twist-up (Biology)
- (1) Personal pencil sharpener with shaving catcher (no sharpeners in the rooms) (Math, Biology)
- (1) Mini stapler and staples (Biology)
- (2) Rectangular erasers - pink pearl (Math) ((1) included in Full Kit)
- (1) 12” metric ruler – durable plastic, (Art, Biology, Math)
- (1) Zippered pencil case, 9”x 10.5” (to hold supplies)

#### Add On Items:

- (1) Collapsible locker shelf for organizing binder/books inside locker, stackable (dimensions: 36 ½” x 11 ¾”) (**Recommended**)
- (1) Zippered pencil case (to hold supplies) 9”x 10.5” (**Required** if you buy the Consumable Kit only **OR** families can opt-out if they have an item at home they want to use)
- (1) **Zippered pencil case**– large (9” x 12”) – (**Optional**) Carries **all** supplies in once case. (including larger items e.g. Index cards, calculator and daily planner) **Spartan** pencil case available when you order your kit through First Day School Supplies.
- (1) **GRAPHING calculator** (Math) **Required**

**CALCULATOR NOTES:** It works best to buy any version of the TI-83 or TI-84. These models are key-for-key compatible; the main difference is a slightly faster processor and more memory in the TI-84. **DO NOT PURCHASE** a TI-89, TI-92, TI-Nspire CAS (non-CAS is OK), or anything with a QWERTY keypad. These calculators have functions that are prohibited during assessments. Students are free to buy another brand (e.g. Casio, Sharp, HP); however, teachers will be instructing based on the TI calculators and will likely be unable to provide support. **ANY OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE FORBIDDEN.**
